Thank you to our participants and leader Tim Hardin with Alachua Audubon for a total species count of 39.

Our trip checklist included 9 warbler species. Only the Common Yellowthroat and Palm Warbler graced us with easy views. The remaining 7 gave us fleeting, high canopy, warbler neck views of an American Redstart, Black-and-White Warbler, Blackburnian Warbler (Drab), Magnolia Warbler (Drab), Northern Parula, Prairie Warbler, and Yellow-throated Warbler
