THE VILLAGE BIRDERS

Bear's Head Hammock & Citrus County Landfill

The club has not birded these 2 venues for several years so it was nice to return. Bear's Head was hard birding as it was a very windy day and many would not come out of the bush. But after playing and pishing we finally were rewarded with the Hermit Thrush and a House Wren. Then we struck it rich with one great tree with 7 good species in a mixed flock that included: Blue-Gray Gnatcatcher, Ruby-crowned Kinglet, Black-and-white Warbler, Palm Warbler, Pine Warbler, Yellow-throated Warbler and Prairie Warbler. As we donned our bright orange vests we were treated to many Bald Eagles, 7 wadding in a pool, at the Landfill. Our target bird there was the Florida Scrub Jay but no luck! In all 53 species for the day, not bad! Warning: the Robins are coming as we had one lone bird atop a tree, the first arrival of the season.
