Today's checklist highlights include:

American Oystercatchers and Black Skimmers at Shell Mound Boat Ramp

American Avocets, Marbled Godwits and Roseate Spoonbills at Cedar Key No. 4 Bridge & Fishing Pier

Clapper Rails calling at the Shell Mound Boat Ramp and on the Cemetery Point Boardwalk

Yellow-throated Warbler on the grounds at the Cedar Key Museum

Royal Terns and a Caspian Tern on the road leading out to the Cedar Key Airport.
