In spite of the unusually cold morning, yesterday, we had a nice species list at the Ft Island Beach, Ft. Island trail, and Inverness Waste Water Treatment facility.

9 of us counted 49 species with 3 additions from a quick stop at Inverness WWT facility and Black-crowned Night herons at Shrimp Landing.

On the Beach

Terns: Common, Royal, Forster's, Sandwich.

Gulls :Laughing, Ring-billed

Shore birds: Spotted, Western, Least Sandpipers, Semipalmated Plovers, Sanderlings, Dunlin, Willet, and Ruddy Turnstone.

Brown Pelican, Bald Eagle, Osprey, Northern Harrier, Tree and Barn Swallows.

Our favorites: Black Skimmers and American Oystercatchers.

Ft Island Trail: Wood Stork, Yellow-bellied Sapsucker, Red-bellied Woodpecker, Eastern Phoebe, etc.

Shrimp Landing: Black-crowned Night heron, adult and juvie.

4 of us stopped at Inverness Waste Water Treatment facility and added Lesser Yellowlegs, Cattle Egret, Sandhill Cranes.
