Hello Birders!

What a great morning 17 of us had at the Oakland Nature Preserve! I'd like to thank Liz (for coming out on her birthday!), Ann, Ron, Sue and others for helping with ID and making sure everyone was able to see the birds that were visible. We heard many birds that were actively eating or hiding but also had some great looks at an osprey with a fish, vultures, northern parulas, mockingbirds, a brown thrasher, woodpeckers and a yellow bellied sapsucker.

We were informed, after most had gone home, that there were painted buntings on the feeder early in the morning while we were on the opposite side of the visitors' center looking at the woodpecker. Some of us were able to catch a glimpse of a young male painted bunting around 1:30 so, since now you all know how close this park is, you can all go back and try to see them! I also took a quick walk along the white and yellow trails and saw two ovenbirds but not any other new species to add to the list.

Oakland has expanded their walking and riding trails and is really worth taking more time to explore.

The list of birds seen is now attached. I will be sure to have The Village Birders' membership forms printed out on our next walk for those who requested them and others who would like to join or renew.
