12 of us met at Wendy's Pond around 8:30am and began checking the pond. Pond was filled with ducks: Ring-necked, Lesser Scaup, Hooded Mergansers, and a couple of Ruddy Ducks.

Mike Brady arrived and said he had just seen the Whooping Cranes that Jim Dinsmore had reported on cr466A.

4 of us decided to see if we could possibly find the Whoopers and off we went.

When we got to the spot where the birds had just been seen they were not there. 2 Sandhill Cranes but no Whooping Cranes.

Oh.... and then the RAIN!

Meanwhile the rest of the Meet and Birders had moved over to Fenney Springs in search of the Otters that show up now and then near the boardwalk.

Rain stopped and we searched for the Otters which had been seen - yesterday.

The list is compiled from birds seen at all 3 spots: Wendy's Pond, Baptist Church Campus (where the Whooping Cranes had been seen) and Fenney Springs.

Most interesting today were the hundreds of Common Crackles flying over us at Fenney Springs. As they flew over I could see many of them were carrying something in their bills.

I got 1 picture - I guess that takes care of the latest hatch of frogs,

If I missed any species today, please let me know. Sorry the day was a bit disorganized....

Please report IF you see the Whooping Cranes. They are very special birds.
