When combining all lists I can report that **106** species were seen in The Villages!

Many birders listed many of the same species.

There were a few single sightings: Baltimore Oriole, Northern Harrier, Pileated Woodpecker, Painted Bunting, Orange-crowned Warbler, Muscovy Duck, Wild Turkey, American Bittern, American Goldfinch, Common Ground Dove, European Starling, Vermilion Flycatcher, White-eyed Vireo, Summer Tanager, Bufflehead, Magpie Duck, Spotted Sandpiper, Song Sparrow, Northern Parula and Brown Pelican.

Any birds in question have been verified.

I'm glad to know Cedar Waxwings and American Robins are here now.
