I counted 41 birds. Additionally Brown Thrasher, House Wren, Sedge Wren, Northern Cardinal were seen by others.

Northern Rough-winged Swallows were unexpected. Cedar Waxwings were flying everywhere, perched Loggerhead Shrikes were favorites but Mom and Dad Sandhill Crane with their Colt were definitely the main show.

Wendy got a picture of THE Sedge Wren for most of us who didn't see it.

I got pictures of the adorable Sandhill Colt. Mom Sandhill, excited not to have Colt underfoot any more, was doing YOGA.
